Who are the Young People of the Church?

Although the United States defines "youth" as ages 12-18 and "young adult" as ages 18-39, the 15th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops will focus on ages 16-29, as defined in the *Preparatory Document*.

Youth Ministry: Youth are defined as young people ages 12-18 in junior high school or high school.

Young Adult Ministry: Young adults are defined as young people ages 19-39 who are single or married, divorced or widowed, and in college, working, unemployed, incarcerated, or in the military.

Pastoral Juvenil: In Latino cultures, "jovenes" are young people ages approximately 16-30 and ministry with them is called "pastoral juvenil"
