How to Report Abuse

Step 1: Emergency

- If anyone is in immediate danger, call 911

Step 2: Mandated Reporters

- If you are a mandated reporter, call the New York State Mandated Reporter hotline:

Step 3: Law Enforcement

- Report the allegation to local police
