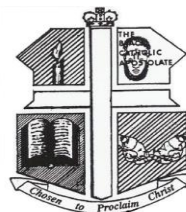

HAVE A QUESTION ABOUT THE MASS?

From time to time we will answer commonly asked questions about different parts of the Mass.

How are the Readings chosen?

The first reading is always taken from the Old Testament (except during the Easter season). The first reading relates to the Gospel reading for that day. The second reading is taken from one of the letters in the New Testament or from the Book of Revelation.

The second reading does not correspond to the Gospel passage but, instead, is a continuation from the previous week's passage.

The Gospel passage is the most important reading because it is Jesus speaking to us through His words and His actions. We sit during the first two readings, but we stand for the Gospel in acknowledgement that we are hearing the Good News of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

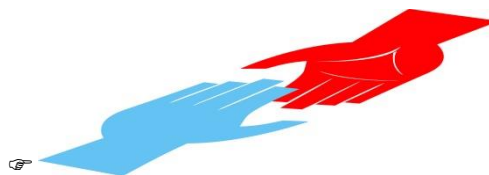
